- Release 1.0.7 has been moved into the UAT environment. The release to production will depend on how testing goes with DCF Quality Assurance. The release will address:
 - Improving Provider Expenditure and Contract Compliance Report Performance
 - Update Reports: Calculation for SA754 arrested percentage is currently inaccurate.



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3. Upcoming Changes and Noteworthy Details

- Enhancements for Q4FY2018–2019 will continue to be gathered over the next several weeks, and enhancements for Q1 FY2019-2020 will also start to make it into the long-range enhancement plan. Please note the enhancements for the Q4 release are still being reviewed and are not final.
- FEI will address several reports that are running much slower than is expected. FEI will work over the next several weeks to increase the performance of the reports.
- The FASAMS Support Team continues to validate the accuracy of data in various FASAMS reports and to identify issues that need to be fixed (e.g., calculation of units and amounts contracted versus units and amounts earned for various projects.)
- Note that there is a monthly maintenance window on the third Saturday of each month from 6 a.m. – 10 a.m.
