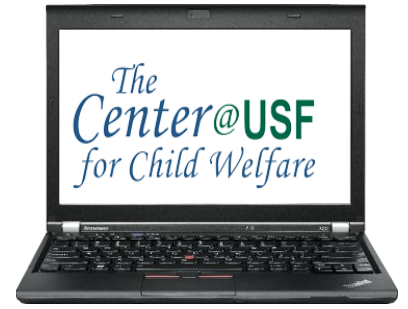


Guide to Staying Virtually Connected During COVID-19

Here are some on-line services and apps that can help you stay connected:

FaceTime

Is a video and audio calling service for Apple devices

Website: www.facetimeapp.com

Cost: Free (pre-installed on Apple devices)

Capacity: You can add up to 32 people at the same time using Group FaceTime

Good for: Any iOS (Apple) device with a forward-facing camera and Mac computer with a webcam.

Facebook Messenger

Is a messaging, calling and video chatting app developed by Facebook.

Website: www.messenger.com

Cost: Free

Capacity: Up to 50 people can video chat on Facebook Messenger at once.

Good for: Computers, Apple devices with iOS 8 and above support Facebook Messenger, as well as Android devices. Download the app in the App or Google Play Store

WhatsApp

Is a messaging service that allows users to send text and voice messages, make voice and video calls, and share images, documents, user locations and other media.

Cost: Free

Capacity: Up to 16 people at the same time

Good for: Computers, Android devices running OS 4.0.3+ and iOS 9+ Apple products. Download the app in the App or Google Play Store

Snapchat

Is a messaging app that lets users exchange pictures and videos (called snaps) that are meant to disappear 24 hours after they are viewed. You can also send short videos, live video chatting and messages creating caricature-like Bitmoji avatars

Cost: Free

Capacity: Up to 16 people at the same time

Good for: Android and Apple mobile devices. Download the app in the App or Google Play Store

Skype

Skype is a video and voice calling service that also allows text messaging, location sharing, file sharing, image sharing, video messaging, voice messaging, group video calls, group audio calls, calls to regular telephones and more. Microsoft developed the app.

Cost: Free

Capacity: Up to 50 people can video chat at the same time using Skype.

Good for: Supports most browsers such as Windows, Mac, iOS (Apple) and Android. Download the app in the App or Google Play Store

Telegram

Is an online instant messaging service that uses end-to-end encryption

Website: www.telegram.org

Cost: Free

Good for: iOS (Apple), Android, Windows Phone & macOS mobile devices

*Users can share photos, videos, audio messages and other files. Users can send messages to other users individually or to groups of up to 200,000 members. Download the app in the App or Google Play Store

Google Duo

Is a video and audio calling app made by Google (similar to Apple's FaceTime)

Cost: Free

Capacity: Up to 12 people

Good for: iOS (Apple) & Android devices. Download the app in the App or Google Play Store

Discord

Website: www.discordapp.com

Is a voice, video and text chat app. Users create servers or rooms for different interests or teams to communicate and keep in touch.

Cost: Free

Capacity: 25 people in the server can join the channel to video chat together

Good for: Computer web browsers, Windows, macOS, Android, iOS (Apple) & Linux. Download the app in the App or Google Play Store

Free Conference Call

Is a conference calling service and comes standard with features such as video chat, audio conferencing, and more. Users also have the ability to record calls

Cost: Free

Capacity: audio and video conferences for up to 1,000 people. Audio conferencing includes a toll number that attendees can dial into

Good for: Use the service with a phone---Create the account online using an email address

Marco Polo

Is a video messaging app that is very popular among teens and tweens. It works like a walkie-talkie – but with video.

Cost: Free

Capacity: Up to 250 users can be in a group together at one time

Good for: Apple and Android devices. Download the app in the App or Google Play Store

Houseparty

What it is: A social networking service for group video chatting, games and fun quizzes using mobile and desktop apps.

Cost: Free

Capacity: Up to eight people can video chat together on Houseparty at the same time.

Good for: iOS (Apple), Android, Mac or Google Chrome. Download the app in the App or Google Play Store

Services for On-Line Meetings & Webinars

Google Hangouts

Is a video conferencing app developed by Google and operates through a Gmail account.

Website: www.hangouts.google.com

Cost: Free for video calls depending on the plan you have subscribed to

Capacity: Video calls can include up to 10 (Gmail, G Suite Basic) or 25 (Business, Education) people.

Good for: The app supports Windows web browsers, Android and iOS (Apple) devices.

*One of the most unique features of Google Hangouts is that it allows users to stream their video calls live on YouTube.

Zoom

Is a video teleconferencing service that provides video and audio chatting, and online meetings

Website: www.zoom.us

Cost: Zoom offers a basic plan free with unlimited meetings. There is a 40-minute time limit on conferences with three or more people. You can upgrade to pro, business or enterprise plans costing \$15 to \$20 each month.

Capacity: Up to 100 people can video chat at the same time using the basic and pro plan on Zoom. While the business plan can host up to 300 people at a time and up to 500 people with the enterprise plan.

Good for: Supports most browsers including iOS (Apple), Android, Blackberry, Windows and Mac, among others. Download the app in the App or Google Play Store

ezTalks

Is a group video, audio, and chatting service. In addition to screen and filing sharing capabilities, ezTalks meetings also include a whiteboard feature, which allows users to add text, highlight, draw shapes, screen capture, etc. with other team members

Cost: Free

Capacity: Up to 1000 participants

Good for: Supports most computer browsers including iOS (Apple) & Android. Download the app in the App or Google Play Store

Join.me

Is an audio and video conferencing service that allows users to personalize their URL and add a customized meeting background. Join.me also integrates with productivity tools like Outlook, Google Calendar, and Office 365

Cost: Free trial—after trial plans range from \$10 - \$30 per month

Capacity: Up to 250 Users

Good for: Supports most computer browsers including iOS (Apple) & Android

Microsoft Teams

Is a video calling, conferencing and text messaging service

Website: [Microsoft Teams](#)

Cost: Anyone can sign up for the free version of Microsoft Teams. Upgraded version has varied price ranges

Capacity: 300 members using the free version, large virtual events can accommodate up to 10,000 participants

Good for: Computers, web browsers, and Android and Apple mobile devices. Download the app in the App or Google Play Store

* Users can share files, schedule meetings directly from Outlook, record meetings, and collaborate on documents using the desktop Office programs and SharePoint Online.

Cisco WebEx

Is a video conferencing service including online meetings, screen sharing, meet recordings and customizable layouts for meeting broadcasting.

Cost: Free, upgraded plans start at \$13.50 /host/month

Capacity: Up to 1000 participants (capacity to have 40,000 participants for large-scale virtual events)

Good for: Supports most computer browsers, iOS (Apple) & Android devices

GoToMeeting

What it is: An online meeting, desktop sharing and video conferencing service

Website: www.gotomeeting.com

Cost: Free for two weeks. After that, you must choose the professional, business or enterprise annual plan ranging from \$16 to \$22+ per month

Capacity: With the professional plan, GoToMeeting holds up to 150 users on the same video call, 250 participants for the business plan, and up to 3000 people for the enterprise plan.

Good for: Supports most web browsers including iOS (Apple), Android, Windows and Mac, among others. Download the app in the App or Google Play Store

*Features polling, automatic webinar invitations and follow-up emails, attendee data, webinar performance, and a sharable video library

[Netflix Party:](#) By synchronizing playback and offering a group chat feature, Netflix Party is a free Google Chrome extension that makes watching movies and TV with your friends easy and fun again.

[Steam:](#) With more than 30,000 video games, 90 million active users and social features like friends' lists and in-game message and voice chat capabilities, Steam is one of the best online gaming services. With no subscription fee and online multiplayer games ranging from as little as \$5. Steam also offers Remote Play Together, which allows you to share a game you're playing at home with up to four friends remotely. This feature streams video, audio and voice between players, making it even easier to hop on and play with your friends.

[Spotify](#) playlists: Connecting with friends can also be as simple as enjoying music together. If that sounds like you, Spotify allows you to create a playlist together. Through a collaborative playlist, you and your friends can add and listen to all of your favorite songs anytime, anywhere. The best part is that contributing and listening to a collaborative playlist doesn't require a Premium account. However, those with free accounts can only add songs via a computer.
