SUBJECT: Community Residential Homes

Legislation passed this year revised chapter 419 Florida Statutes' definition of "Community residential home". Effective July 1, 2006, the statutes now require all dwellings licensed as community residential homes comply with notice to the local zoning authority of the intent to be licensed and operate such a home. Family foster homes with "live-in" caregivers do not meet the requirements for notice under this section. To expedite this process and assist applicants, the attached and referenced forms should be utilized.

Applicants for licensing under this section should be provided with a copy of Children and Families Form #1786 and provided with assistance as needed in obtaining the required information. The "Important Notice" (attached) can be used to assist applicants in obtaining the necessary information. Applicants for licensure of dwellings providing a living environment for 7-14 residents, also must ensure notification of local government by filing Children and Families Form #1785, which should also be provided upon request by the applicant.
