Review and Approval of February 5, 2025 Meeting Minutes

A motion was entered to approve the February 5, 2025, minutes. The motion was carried. The minutes were approved with no opposition.

Commission Update

Commission Chair Jay Reeve briefly discussed several bills moving through the Legislature that contain language related to commission recommendations. A few of the bills discussed were Senate Bill 168, Senate Bill 1620, House Bill 1207 and House Bill 1439. This year's in-person commission meeting will be held on September 2, 2025, at the 2025 Florida Children and Families Summit in Orlando. Aaron Platt will confirm with DCF leadership that the subcommittee meeting is locked in to occur during the summit.

Legislative Bill Update – SB 168

Dr. Heather Flynn provided an update on the Tristan Murphy Act (SB 168). The Tristan Murphy Act includes a section directing the Commission on Mental Health and Substance Use Disorders Data Analysis subcommittee and the Northwest Regional Data Center to coordinate on the creation of a centralized and integrated Behavioral Health Care Data Repository. The first deadline is December 21, 2025 and requires a developed plan for implementation and ongoing operation be submitted.

AISP Presentation

Dr. Amy Hawn Nelson, Research Faculty at the University of Pennsylvania and Director of Training and Technical Assistance for Actionable Intelligence for Social Policy (AISP) AISP develops integrated data systems for social policy analysis and program form. Dr. Nelson shared her experience with developing shared data infrastructure.

The Data Analysis subject matter experts from Northwest Regional Data Center discussed possible data governance structures for the Behavioral Health Data Repository. The need for a data governance plan to be successful was emphasized. It was also suggested that legal representatives be included early in the process.

Chair Reeve suggested that subcommittee Chair Commissioner Moore invite representatives from other agencies as subject matter experts. Namely, representatives from the Department of Education and the Department of Juvenile Justice. Doing so will ensure early involvement and buy-in of the agencies that may submit behavioral data into the Repository.
