SCOPE

INITIAL REQUEST & ASSUMPTIONS

Business Statement

FASAMS should not require the users to log into the portal to determine if a file was imported successfully. The users should be automatically notified upon completion of a job.

Scope Definition

The scope of this enhancement is to modify FASAMS to automatically send email notifications when an import job has Completed.

- Send the email to the user who initiated the job.
- If the job completed with no errors, the email body would indicate that the job was successful and there were no errors.

EXISTING FUNCTIONALITY

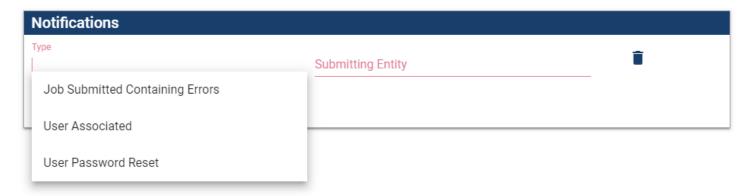
FASAMS currently has the ability to send an email notification for the following notification types:

All users will be able to turn on the "Job Processed Successfully" notification option for their own profile.

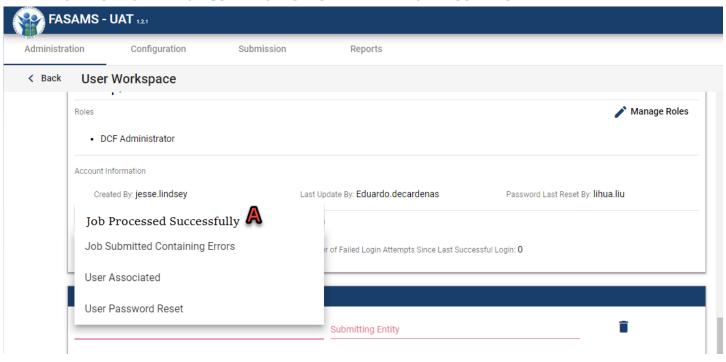

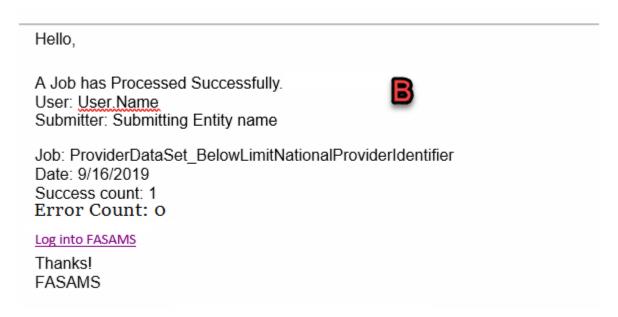
