SCOPE

INITIAL REQUEST & ASSUMPTIONS

Business Statement

FASAMS Pamphlet 155-2 Chapter 5 Treatment Episode Data requires submitting entities to submit Performance Outcome Measurements updated every 90 days following the initial admission or transfer admission and the individual does not have a Final Discharge for the Treatment Episode. If a submitting entity does not complete a Performance Outcome Measure within 90 days of the last Performance Outcome Measurements, it will be included in an exception report.

Scope Definition

The report can be run ad hoc at anytime by DCF staff. The report will be run based on open Admissions and their last Performance Outcome Measures. The "open Admissions" in this report covers all Admissions that do not have a Transfer Discharge and are from the Treatment Episodes that have not been closed with a Final Discharge yet. It will calculate several metrics that reflect the number Admissions and Clients that have not received Performance Outcome Measure data for more than 90 days, and for how long they have not received updates. This report will be available to all FASAMS users, but the client-level Personal Health Information (PHI) data will be visible only to users for their respective areas.

EXISTING FUNCTIONALITY

FASAMS currently collects Performance Outcome Measure information on Treatment Episodes with no way to report on 'delinquent' Treatment Episodes that have not received POMs updates over the following 90 days.

PROPOSED FUNCTIONALITY

A new report will be developed to show all Clients and Admissions that have not had an update to Performance Outcome Measures over the last 90 days.

The report will be run on data from selected Submitting Entities only, and provide information at the following levels:


- Across all selected Submitting Entities/ State-level
- Submitting Entity level
- Provider level
- Client/ Admission level visible only to users with proper Submitting Entity Group association)

The report will calculate the following metrics:

- The number of clients with active admissions
- The number of clients with active admissions and have not received Performance Outcome Measure (POM) updates for more than 90 days
- The percentage of clients who have not received POM updates for more than 90 days
- The number of active admissions
- The number of active admissions that have not had POM updates for more than 90 days, with a breakdown by the length of time with no POM updates



- The percentage of active admissions that have not had POM updates for more than 90 days
- The median, mean and standard deviation of these "delinquent" admissions' length of time with no POM updates

1.8	Print as PDF The width of the table should fit into one page when the report is saved as a PDF from SSRS.
