Note: Florida's 2018 substate level data is unavailable. The 2020-2021 OTP Needs Assessment uses the most recently published National Survey on Drug Use and Health (NSDUH) substate estimates. These estimates present the United States' substate estimates for 15 measures of substance use and mental illness based on combined 2014 to 2016 NSDUH data (Column E and G), previously used in the 2019-2020 OTP Needs Assessment. The Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) 2018 Annual Report published the perceived need for substance use treatment among people age 12 or older who needed but did not receive specialty substance use treatment in the past year for 2018. However, the perceived need among people age 18 or older is required to be consistent with the previous needs assessment (Column J). Florida Population estimates for
