### 4. Remove Subcontract and Dependencies (521775)

- DCF and the managing entities have determined that the subcontract data set, and its
  associated rules, create a burden for submitting Service Events into FASAMS. To resolve
  this, DCF wants all dependencies on the Subcontract to be removed via configuration
  and thoroughly tested by FEI.
- FEI will identify all rules associated to the Subcontract, write a script to automatically disabled those rules at deployment, and fully test the system to confirm Service Events have no submission barrier due to Subcontract rules.
